Our church is made up of distinctive, meaningful elements.

The small circles which make up the arrows below represent the wide and rich diversity of people who make up our church family. People from the many nations and languages of our world. People of all shapes and sizes and ages, colors and cultures, educational and employment experiences, and religious backgrounds.

The circles form arrows: one coming down from the upper left, one moving up from the lower right, one pressing to the center from the lower left, and one moving from the center to the upper right. Each arrow represents one of the four spiritual dynamics to which we have committed ourselves:

The **Grace Arrow** (the gold arrow coming from above) represents **Grace** - the everlasting gospel, the good news of God's unconditional love toward fallen humanity. **Grace** freely gives salvation to us and unambiguously demonstrates the Divine, unconquerable love through the gift of Jesus. For our congregation this dynamic reminds us of our commitment to resource the establishment of **Grace** as the preeminent ethos, the characteristic spirit of the Winnemucca Seventh-day Adventist Church, and to manifest **Grace** at the center of all we are, all we do, and all we believe.

The **Worship Arrow** (moving upward toward the Grace Arrow) depicts the spiritual perspective that everything we do in this life can be a **Heartfelt Response** to God's gift of grace to us. It reminds every member and all our church leaders that in our planning and in the performance of our ministries to each other we will do all within our power to **Support** and **Encourage** a comprehensive response to God's grace, a life of praise.

Look at the **Central Space** in between all the arrows and you'll see the cross, the unmistakable symbol that for two thousand years now has reminded Christians of our firm foundation in Jesus. **Being Christ-centered is the Winnemucca goal.** Jesus is for us "the great truth around which all other truths cluster." We strive to focus every study, every sermon, every worship experience, every act of service on our Savior.

The **Community Arrow** (moving from the lower left of the logo to the center) illustrates our church family growing together in grace. In large worship experiences and small study groups, our **Community** nourishes, educates, and challenges us, attempting to provide every possible spiritual advantage. Maintained by the generous giving of its members, the church establishes a <u>safe</u> place to ask questions, provides opportunities to utilize our spiritual gifts, and encourages us to seek God's face wherever we can find Him.

The Service Arrow (moving from the center out toward others) reminds us that a life of faith also embraces Sharing the treasures that so enrich our lives. The places we live, go to school, work, and shop, are filled with people just like us; people with needs. So we search for ways to meet those needs, finding in such acts of Service joy in our own lives, and opportunities to reveal the gracious, caring character of the God we worship.

CHURCH FAMILY LIFE - PLANNING AHEAD

Welcome Visitors - We are honored that you have chosen to fellowship with us today. We pray that as a result of your worship with us you will experience the presence of God, the grace of God, be inspired with hope, feel loved by the community of faith, be transformed, be challenged to service, and enjoy excellence. Please plan to join us in the Fellowship Hall immediately following the service for Sabbath Dinner, provided especially for you by our church family.

Today's Worship Service In this important series, Ekklesia, The Church, we have learned that WE are the church. We have discovered the principles of Fellowship, Teaching, Prayer, Communion, Mission, Authority, Worship, and Victory. Church is not for the rugged individual. Yes, Christ died for each individual. However, when He returns to earth, it will not be for individuals, but for the church - FELLOWSHIP. We also looked at something else the church is supposed to do; that is, TEACHING. If Fellowship and Teaching can be likened to the arms and legs of the Ekklesia, PRAYER must be the lifeblood of the Church. Next, we chose to participate in Christ's command of remembrance. Communion is more than unleavened or leavened bread—it is COMMUNION with Jesus Christ and each other. Then we studied about MISSION and the church's marching orders. We also looked at Church Leadership and AUTHORITY. Following this, we looked at WORSHIP and discovered worship is not about us - it's about God! Last week we looked at the big picture of the church with all its faults. However, the church will be VICTORIOUS! Last week we listened to God's STATE OF THE CHURCH addresses to the seven churches listed in the book of Revelation. Today, we receive a scroll addressed to our own local church - our own STATE OF THE CHURCH address. This series is meant to lead us to think about what we do as a church and why we do those basic things. We all have ideas about what a church should do, but those ideas are often formed more by our own experiences with the church than by what God says in the Bible. Journey with us as we study one of the Basics of Christian life.

We are going through the book of John, (chapter by chapter). This week we finish the gospel of John by viewing and studying John 21. Unite with us as we study together God's Word.
