Our church is made up of distinctive, meaningful elements.

The small circles which make up the arrows below represent the wide and rich diversity of people who make up our church family. People from the many nations and languages of our world. People of all shapes and sizes and ages, colors and cultures, educational and employment experiences, and religious backgrounds.

The circles form arrows: one coming down from the upper left, one moving up from the lower right, one pressing to the center from the lower left, and one moving from the center to the upper right. Each arrow represents one of the four spiritual dynamics to which we have committed ourselves:

The **Grace Arrow** (the gold arrow coming from above) represents **Grace** - the everlasting gospel, the good news of God's unconditional love toward fallen humanity. **Grace** freely gives salvation to us and unambiguously demonstrates the Divine, unconquerable love through the gift of Jesus. For our congregation this dynamic reminds us of our commitment to resource the establishment of **Grace** as the preeminent ethos, the characteristic spirit of the Winnemucca Seventh-day Adventist Church, and to manifest **Grace** at the center of all we are, all we do, and all we believe.

The **Worship Arrow** (moving upward toward the Grace Arrow) depicts the spiritual perspective that everything we do in this life can be a **Heartfelt Response** to God's gift of grace to us. It reminds every member and all our church leaders that in our planning and in the performance of our ministries to each other we will do all within our power to **Support** and **Encourage** a comprehensive response to God's grace, a life of praise.

Look at the **Central Space** in between all the arrows and you'll see the cross, the unmistakable symbol that for two thousand years now has reminded Christians of our firm foundation in Jesus. **Being Christ-centered is the Winnemucca goal.** Jesus is for us "the great truth around which all other truths cluster." We strive to focus every study, every sermon, every worship experience, every act of service on our Savior.

The **Community Arrow** (moving from the lower left of the logo to the center) illustrates our church family growing together in grace. In large worship experiences and small study groups, our **Community** nourishes, educates, and challenges us, attempting to provide every possible spiritual advantage. Maintained by the generous giving of its members, the church establishes a **safe** place to ask questions, provides opportunities to utilize our spiritual gifts, and encourages us to seek God's face wherever we can find Him.

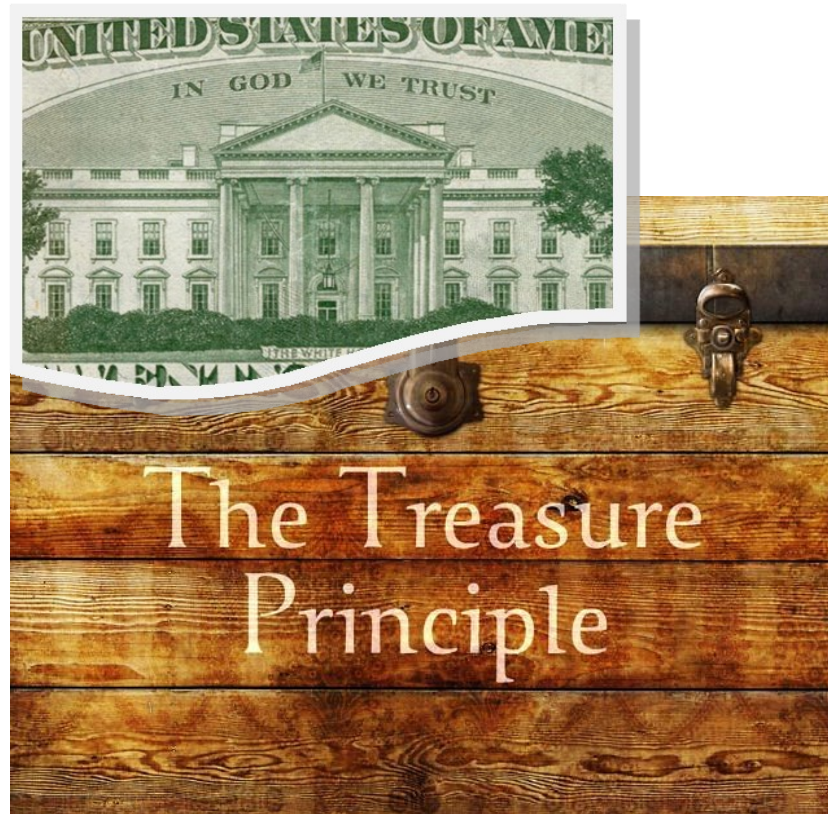

CHURCH FAMILY LIFE - PLANNING AHEAD

Welcome Visitors - We are honored that you have chosen to fellowship with us today. We pray that as a result of your worship with us you will experience the presence and the grace of God, be inspired with hope, feel loved by the community of faith, be transformed, be challenged to service, and enjoy excellence. Please plan to join us in the Fellowship Hall immediately following the service for Sabbath Dinner, provided especially for you by our church family.

This Morning's Worship Service Continues Our Spring Theme - In God We Trust / The Treasure Principle - The goal of this series is to lead us to a better understanding of God's design of partnership with Him. Interestingly, over 15% of all the words attributed to Jesus deal with the topic of money - more than heaven and hell combined. So far, we have learned that we are truly "super-wealthy". If we make more than \$2/day, by the rest of the world's standard - we are rich! Therefore, in all the instances where Jesus talks about the difficulties surrounding the 'rich' - He is talking about us! God wants us not to be obsessed with treasure here on earth, but to "store up treasure in heaven." Next we discovered that when we give to God, He will bless us. This is not the "prosperity gospel" many pontificate on the television, but rather the principle of giving back to God who is the true owner of everything. This morning's study identifies materialism and affluence (affluenza) as a disease and is poison to our eternal destiny. Each worshipper will be confronted with the question, "Where is my treasure?"

Join Us As We Close the Sabbath with Vespers - Gather with friends and interests for our Vespers Service with a Bible study as we continue viewing and studying Acts 5. Popcorn, smoothies and a night of table games will follow our study.

Mid-Week Prayer Meeting - This week's Prayer Meeting / Bible Study will meet Wednesday nights at 6:00pm. Join us as we continue our 13-week series *The Great Controversy Countdown*. This week: "The Great Controversy in the Life of Christ - #8."

Financial Peace University continues every Thursday through May. Financial Peace University (FPU) consists of a 13-week video curriculum—taught by financial expert Dave Ramsey—that incorporates small-group discussions to encourage accountability and discipleship. We have now completed over 75% of the course. We will conduct another class this coming fall.
