Prayer Meeting - GC Countdown




Sabbath Vespers

Pastor's Corner: The Great Hope Project

Do you remember when you were a kid on the playground and someone would come up to you, stick their finger in your chest and utter the words, "I challenge you?" Did you walk away? Well, our local church family has received a challenge!

Seventh-day Adventist General Conference President, Ted N. C. Wilson, is initiating a project which I know will peak your interest. The challenge to the world field is to distribute massive quantities of The Great Controversy as part of the Church's world-wide "Tell The World" emphasis, and a complement to the Revival and Reformation emphasis. Additionally, Wilson is encouraging all church members to read the complete Great Controversy by the end of 2012.

NORTH AMERICAN DIVISION THE GREAT HOPE PROJECT OBJECTIVE

Distribution of three million copies of the Great Hope, an 11-chapter abridged version of the Great Controversy by Ellen G. White (formatted by the E. G. White Estate). The Great Hope will be printed in English, Spanish, and French.

I have, together with the Nevada-Utah Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, procured a copy for each family in our church family. But there is a catch - you can't keep it, but must give it away!

I want to do my part in encouraging you to join in this initiative. I have ordered 500 copies for our church to distribute during the coming summer months. Will you help to sponsor this special evangelistic and witnessing campaign? Through May 15, the cost for each booklet has been reduced to 39 cents. Our challenge is to raise the \$195 to fund this project. I have received a

pledge for \$100 from one of our church families. Will you join them and help meet this challenge?

Currently we are studying the Great Controversy Countdown in our Wednesday night Bible Study. In a few more weeks we will start a weekly in-depth study of the complete Great Controversy. We are doing our part to meet the challenge issued by our church leaders. The great question is - "Are you willing to stand up and individually do your part in meeting this chal-

lenge?" I pray that you will join us in responding back with an enthusiastic, "YES, WE WILL!"
